• Ballet variations by age group.

Petite and Mini Divisions (Ages 10 and under)

Dancers in these age divisions are limited to specific variations, often from the first or second act of a ballet.

- ***Coppelia***: 1st Act Variation.
- ***Don Quixote***: Cupid Variation.
- ***Giselle***: Peasant Variations.
- ***La Bayadere***: Three Shades Variations.
- ***La Fille Mal Gardee***: Pas de Deux Variations.
- ***Le Corsaire***: Odalisque Variations.
- ***Paquita***: All variations, excluding principal variations.
- ***Raymonda***: All variations, excluding principal variations.
- ***Swan Lake***: Pas de Trois Variations.
- ***The Sleeping Beauty***: Variations of Fairies, Blue Bird Pas de Deux Variations.
- ***The Flames of Paris***: Pas de Deux Variations.

Junior, Senior, and Adult Divisions (Ages 11 and up)

This group is permitted to perform a wider array of variations, including more challenging pas de deux and full variations.

- ***La Bayadere***: Pas de Deux and all Variations.
- ***Coppelia***: Pas de Deux and all Variations.
- ***Don Quixote***: Pas de Deux and all Variations.
- ***Giselle***: Giselle Variation, Act I Peasant Pas de Deux and Variations, and Pas de Deux Variations from Act II.
- ***Le Corsaire***: Pas d'Esclave and Variations, Odalisque Variations, Jardin Anime, Act III Pas de Deux and Variations.
- ***The Sleeping Beauty***: Variations of Fairies, Blue Bird Pas de Deux and Variations, Wedding Pas de Deux and Variations.
- ***Swan Lake***: Pas de Trois and Variations, Odette's Variation, Act II Black Swan Pas de Deux and Variations.
